Yatama Fund

- Yatama means Orphans in Urdu – so this fund is for orphans
- In 1989, Hazrat Khalifatul Masih IV(rh) initiated this scheme to take care of 100 orphans as thanks to Allah Almighty for the 100 years of Ahmadiyyat
- This scheme is now extended to taking care of orphans all around the world



Yatama Fund

“...all Pakistani Ahmadis who live in USA, Canada, Europe and the UK should participate in this scheme. **What greater glad-tiding can there be for a believer than that he/she will be given a place in the feet of the Holy Prophet (sa).** I have estimated that if each person of Ahmadi households of the UK, Europe, Canada and USA paid £7 to £10 per head annually towards this scheme a huge burden of the Yatama scheme can be met. £10 per year is a meager amount for people living here; however, it can play a huge role in making the future of many orphans bright. Those who are well-off can give more.”

Syedna Bilal Fund

- Announced by Hazrat Khalifatul Masih IV (rh), in his Friday Sermon on March 14, 1986 – named it Syedna Bilal fund
- For the welfare of the families of Martyrs who have sacrificed their lives for the cause of Ahmadiyyat

“...no Ahmadi who is killed in the cause of Allah, shall ever depart from this world thinking of what will become of his wife and children. In Jama‘at Ahmadiyya the children of such people do not become orphans. This is a living Jama‘at and it is impossible that it should forget its duty towards those who have sacrificed their lives”

(Friday Sermon March 14, 1986)



Syedna Bilal Fund

Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V(aa) said regarding Burkina Faso's martyrs:

“In order to meet the needs of the families of Ahmadī martyrs and to help them become self-sufficient, the Syedna Bilal Fund was established during the time of Ḥaḍrat Khalīfatul Masīh IV(rh). Whoever wishes to help the families of the martyrs should contribute to this fund. **This is not a favour we are doing to them but it is our duty to take care of their needs. Citing a quote of the Promised Messiah(as), Huzoor(aa) said: These martyrs have lived up to the test, and now it is the turn of those who are left behind. May a grant us fortitude in our faith and conviction.**”

Maryam Shadi Fund

- Hazrat Khalifatul Masih IV (rh) launched a fund in his Friday sermon of February 21, 2003
- Later called the Maryam Shadi Fund, named after his mother
- Meant for helping those deserving parents who need assistance in providing for their daughter's marriages



Maryam Shadi Fund

"As an expression of gratitude, I would also like to say something about my mother. She had great sympathy for the poor...and she used to arrange for the dowry of poor girls...In her memory...and in order to bring blessings upon her soul...I announce that those whose daughters are about to be married and they are in need of assistance...they should, without hesitation, write to me. They shall be adequately provided for and they will, to a considerable extent, be able to meet the expenses of dowry. Even if I personally do not possess the means, Allah's Jama'at, by His grace, is rich and has enough money."

Maryam Shadi Fund

- Donate it to generously especially when have weddings in our families
- Wedding clothes and limited items accepted after strict review by local Sadr and Regional Coordinator



Khidmat Khalq Fund

- Fund for Khidmat Khalq (Service to Humanity or Social Services)
- Used by Lajna for various Khidmat Khalq activities – as needed
