How To Use The Lajna Syllabus 2025-2026

By the grace of Allah Ta'ala, Lajna Imā'illah Canada has started a new year as of October 2025 and with it a new Lajna Syllabus is being introduced for our **Ta'lim & Tarbiyat Lajna Classes**.

WHO IS THIS SYLLABUS FOR?

The Lajna syllabus has been designed for all Lajna members, including Lajna students.

The syllabus covers basic fundamentals of Islam and tackles current day issues faced by Ahmadi Muslim women.

Lajna members in Canada come from different cultural backgrounds and life experiences. The Lajna classes are a space to learn from each other so that we have a broader understanding of the world we live in and a stronger connection to each other in our sisterhood.

CLASS STRUCTURE

As before, this syllabus covers Talim & Tarbiyat both departments will work together to organize the Lajna classes. Please note the following:

- Every majlis is expected to hold a minimum of **TWO** classes per centre (so if a majlis has more than one centre that holds this class, then each centre should hold class at least twice).
- Each Majlis is expected to hold a minimum of two classes in English and two in Urdu.
 - there is no longer any exclusive "Lajna Student class" to be held.
- If ALL Lajna members understand English, then a Majlis does not need to organize a class in Urdu. However, if an Urdu class is necessary, then an English class must be arranged as well.
- As per the instructions of Sayyedna Hazrat Khalifatul Masih (may Allah be his Helper), classes must be held in-person and not online.

SUGGESTED CLASS AGENDA

- Majalis are to hold a minimum of 2 Lajna classes a month that are at a minimum, 1 hour long each; therefore, the monthly material should be easily covered within at least 2 hours.
- The class should only be in one language; the suggested agenda does not include time for translation.

HOW ARE WE LEARNING?

- The syllabus has been divided into terms, and each term has 4 months. Each term is then further broken down into months, with content to be covered in Class 1 and 2, per month.
- **THERE WILL BE NO CLASSES IN THE MONTHS OF MARCH, JULY AND AUGUST.**
- As a Lajna member, and student of these classes, I will Inshallah attend and participate in my local Lajna classes and on my own time, I will take the time to study the Lajna Syllabus and explore all the additional resources and links that have been provided.

How To Use The Lajna Syllabus 2025-2026

- As a teacher, I will take the time to properly prepare for the class by studying the additional material and making notes and then put together a plan for how I am going to teach the class (tools I can use for example: PowerPoint slides/[Prezi](#)/[Slidesgo](#), [Kahoot](#) or [Mentimeter](#), zoom poll, etc.)
- A new feature of the Lajna syllabus is the effort to offer an interactive learning experience. **Much of the content in this syllabus includes hyperlinks (in blue).** When we click on the underlined words, a new tab will open with an article/video/book that will help us learn about a topic in-depth.
- Teachers are kindly requested to read the content mentioned in the syllabus at home. In class, teachers are requested to conduct meaningful discussions

- We will be studying 2 Chapters of the Holy Quran. Links have been provided that take you directly to the individual verse and at the top of the section we have included a Self-Study/Teaching Guide where there is a list of commentaries (books of Tafseer), Darsul Quran and Friday Sermon videos that discuss the relevant verse.
- When you Recite the Arabic verses, please ensure that we are following the rules of Tarteel - and revise the rules in class
- Al Islam is pleased to offer these digital tools to help you deepen your study of the Holy Quran. Explore features such as:

 - Commentaries from Bukhari, the Promised Messiah (as) and the Khulafa
 - Urdu Tarjamatul Quran Classes segmented verse-by-verse

- This year we will be studying the Islamic Months in accordance with the Lunar Calendar. We will be delving into the Islamic significance of these months.

Malfuzat Volume 1

- Each month, approximately 1-2 pages have been assigned from *Malfuzat Volume 1*. After reading the assigned section

Book of the Promised Messiah (as)

- We will be reading *Haqiqatul Wahi* this year but it will NOT be covered during class. Members are expected to read on their own and then if they want, either join their local book club (if it's organized) or a National Online Book Club that will be held each term.

Conditions of Bai'at

- Each Month, we will be discussing 1 condition of Ba'a'it through scenario based questions and discussions. Please use these questions as a guide to conduct meaningful discussions.

Salat

- We will be learning the practical example of the Holy Prophet (sas) and how he performed Salat

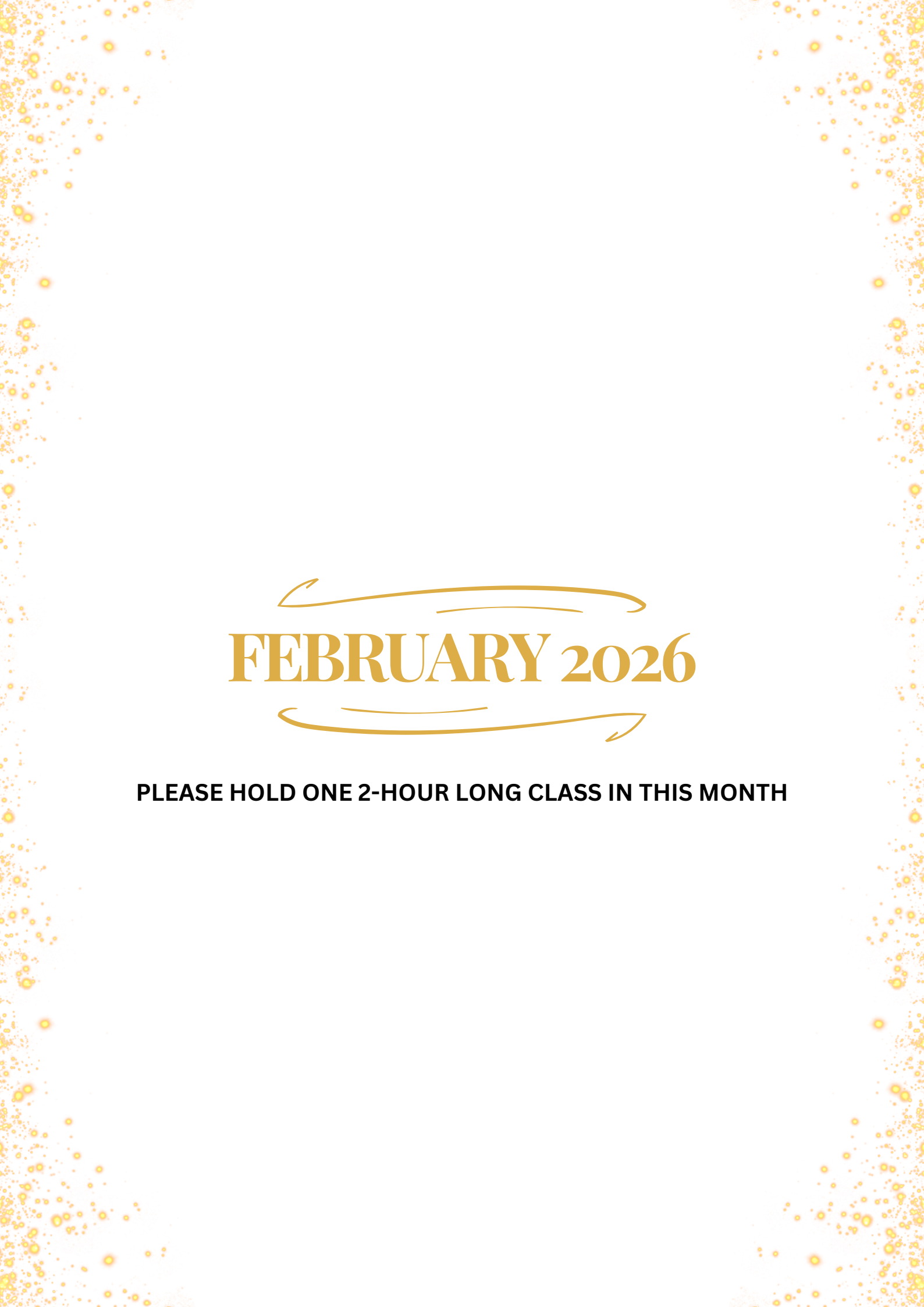

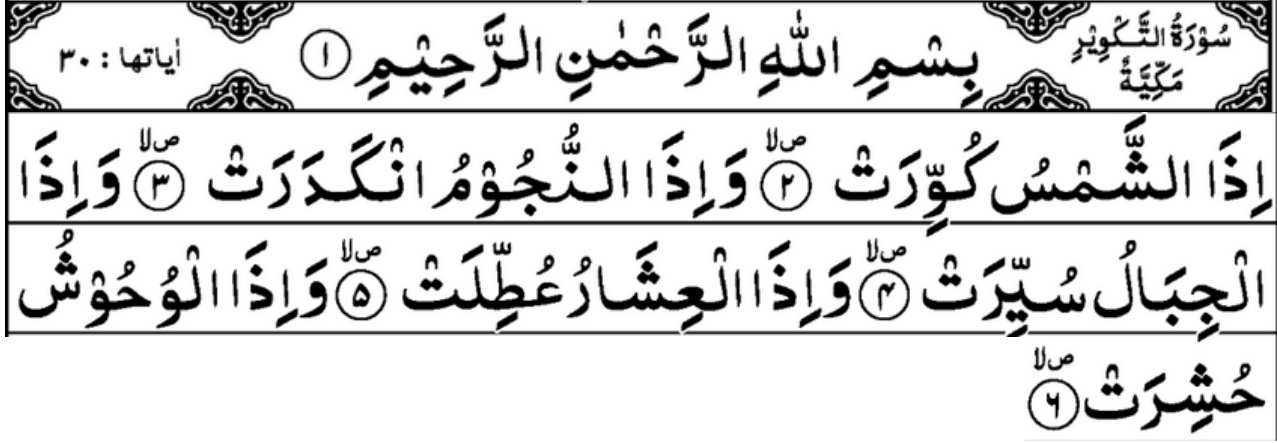

The Truth About the Split

آئینہ صداقت

Truth About the Split, the English translation of A'ina'-e-Sadaqat, written by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II^(ra), is a detailed reply to The Split by Maulawi Muhammad Ali, who after having denied the institution of Khilafat had seceded from the main body of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jama'at and established his party headquarters at Lahore. Truth About the Split has been divided into two main parts. The first part consists of the refutation of the eleven misstatements and unfounded charges leveled against Hazrat

Khalifatul-Masih II^(ra) in The Split, and of the thoroughly fabricated story of the Ahmadiyya dissension. First few misstatements revolve around a person named Zahiruddin who was believed to be, by the Lahore Party, the originator of the belief of the prophethood of the Promised Messiah^(as). Another controversy was whether those who denied the Promised Messiah^(as) should be regarded as Muslims or Kafir-bil-Ma'mur. In fact, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II^(ra) had already proved that the Promised Messiah^(as) regarded them as the latter. Another controversy generated by Maulawi

Muhammad Ali was that people had pledged Bai'at with the second Khalifa in ignorance, and that they had later renounced their Bai'at with him. The second part of the book deals with the true story of the split. It elaborates how Khawaja Kamaluddin,

Maulawi Muhammad Ali and few others intrigued to bring down the Institution of Khilafat during the time of Hazrat Khalifatul Masih I^(ra), how they openly showed their hostility after his demise by proposing delay in the election of the next Khalifa, and what finally impelled them to set up their own separate organization. The book then sets out, in clear terms—in the light of Al-Wasiyyat by the Promised Messiah^(as)—as to who (Anjuman or the Khalifa) should actually succeed the Promised Messiah^(as).

Hazrat Khalifatul Masih III_(rta) saw a vision in which an elderly gentleman said to him,
“If every member of this community recites the durood 200 times:

سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ اللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى مُحَمَّدٍ وَآلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

He then said those who are of a mature age, between the ages of 15-25, should recite it at least 100 times a day, children should recite it at least 33 times; and younger children should repeat after their parents three or four times. Alongside this one should recite Istighfar 100 times.

Furthermore, I wish to add that one should recite:

رَبِّ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ خَادِمُكَ رَبِّ فَاحْفَظْنِي وَانصُرْنِي وَارْحَمْنِي

100 times. [Recite this], especially during these days and generally going forward. In this vision, Hazrat Khalifatul Masih III_(rta) was shown that if you do this, then you will enter a secure fort, in which Satan can never enter. The walls of the fort are made of iron, which reach the heavens. Thus, no crack will remain through which Satan can enter. (Report Majlis-e-Mushawarat Jamaat-e-Ahmadiyya 1968, p. 233)

The Holy Prophet^(sas) has said, “Whoever prays during the nights of Ramadan while fulfilling the requirements of faith and seeking reward, his past sins will be forgiven.” (Sahih al-Bukhari, Kitab as-sawm, Hadith 1901)

This indeed is His blessed declaration.

Now, one might think that when a person consistently strives to make good deeds a part of their daily life – paying attention to prayers, focusing on Tahajjud, offering nawafil – it will lead to greater devotion during Ramadan. Those who are committed to regular worship perform these virtues with this intention. However, some people mistakenly believe that merely waking up for prayers during the nights of Ramadan is sufficient.

Indeed, humans are prone to making mistakes, but Allah the Almighty is also extremely gracious and merciful, and He is Forgiving. Therefore, he has granted us this opportunity that if one has made mistakes in this regard during the past year, one can now renew their commitment and try to uphold it; that going forward, they will fulfill the rights of worshipping Allah the Almighty and they will perform all those virtuous deeds, which Allah the Almighty has commanded them to perform.

Therefore, a Muslim must especially remember that the worship prescribed by Allah the Almighty during Ramadan is meant to instil true guidance within them. And true guidance is not something to be developed for just one month; rather, it is something that should become a permanent part of one's life. Allah the Almighty has stated that He repeatedly brings Ramadan as a reminder and as an expression of His mercy so that those who have strayed may once again remember their duties.

(بخاری کتاب الصوم باب من صام رمضان ایسانا ... حدیث 1901)

بیشک یہ آپ کا ارشاد ہے۔ اب یہ سوچ ہو سکتی ہے کہ جب انسان مستقل اپنی زندگی کا حصہ ان نیکیوں کو بنانے کی کوشش کرے اور نمازوں کی طرف توجہ دے، تہجد کی طرف توجہ دے، نوافل کی طرف توجہ دے تو رمضان میں زیادہ توجہ پیدا ہوگی۔ جو عبادت کرنے والے ہیں، مستقل عبادت کرنے والے ہیں وہ اس سوچ کے ساتھ یہ کام کرتے ہیں۔ لیکن بعض لوگ سمجھتے ہیں کہ صرف رمضان میں ہی راتوں کو اٹھ لیا یہی کافی ہے۔

انسان غلطیوں کا پتلا ہے، غلطیاں ہوتی ہیں لیکن اللہ تعالیٰ بھی بڑا رحمان اور رحیم ہے۔ وہ بخشنے والا بھی ہے اس لیے اس نے ہمیں یہ موقع مہیا کیا ہے کہ اگر تمہارے سے سال کے دوران میں غلطیاں ہو گئی ہیں تو اب نئے سرے سے یہ عہد کرو اور پھر اس پر قائم رہنے کی کوشش کرو کہ تم آئندہ اللہ تعالیٰ کی عبادت کا حق ادا کرنے والے بنو گے اور ان تمام نیکیوں کو بجالانے والے بنو گے جن کا اللہ تعالیٰ نے حکم دیا۔

پس اس بات کو ایک مسلمان کو خاص طور پر یاد رکھنا چاہیے کہ رمضان کی عبادت کا جو اللہ تعالیٰ نے حکم دیا ہے وہ اس لیے دیا ہے کہ تمہارے اندر رشد اور ہدایت پیدا ہو اور رشد ایک مہینے کے لیے نہیں پیدا ہوتی بلکہ مستقل پیدا کرنے والی چیز ہے۔ اللہ تعالیٰ نے یہی بات فرمائی ہے کہ اللہ تعالیٰ یاد دہانی کروانے کے لیے اور اپنی رحمانیت کا اظہار کرنے کے لیے بار بار رمضان کو لے کے آتا ہے تاکہ انسان جو بھولا بھٹکا ہے اس کو دوبارہ اپنے فرائض یاد آجائیں۔

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رمضان

یہ اسلامی کیلنڈر کا نواں مہینہ ہے۔ رمضان وہ ماہ مبارک ہے جس کا تمام مسلمان سارا سال بڑی شدت سے انتظار کرتے ہیں۔ اس کے نام رکھنے کی وجہ تسمیہ یہ ہے کہ جس وقت یہ نام رکھا گیا تھا اس وقت گرمی اور سورج کی شدت عروج پر ہوتی تھی۔ یہ لقاء الہی کا مہینہ ہے۔ یہ ماہ مبارک اللہ تعالیٰ کے فضلوں اور رحمتوں کو حاصل کرنے والا ہے۔

سیدنا حضرت اقدس مسیح موعود علیہ الصلوٰۃ والسلام فرماتے ہیں: ”رمضان سورج کی تپش کو کہتے ہیں۔ رمضان میں چونکہ انسان اکل و شرب اور تمام جسمانی لذتوں پر صبر کرتا ہے۔ دوسرے اللہ تعالیٰ کے احکام کے لئے ایک حرارت اور جوش پیدا کرتا ہے۔ روحانی اور جسمانی حرارت اور تپش مل کر رمضان ہوا... رمضان اس حرارت کو بھی کہتے ہیں جس سے پتھر وغیرہ گرم ہو جاتے ہیں۔“ (ملفوظات، جلد اول صفحہ ۱۳۶)

*قرآن کریم جیسی اعلیٰ و ارفع کتاب کے نزول کا آغاز بھی اس مبارک مہینہ میں شروع ہوا اور خدا کا یہ کلام بھی اسی مہینہ میں ۲۳ سال کے عرصہ میں تکمیل کو پہنچا۔ رمضان کے مہینہ میں کثرت سے قرآن کریم کی تلاوت کرنی چاہیے۔ حضور ﷺ فرماتے ہیں۔ ماہ رمضان کے استقبال کے لیے یقیناً سارا سال جنت سجائی جاتی ہے۔ اور جب رمضان آتا ہے تو جنت کہتی ہے کہ یا اللہ اس مہینے میں اپنے بندوں کو میرے لیے خاص کر دے۔ (نبیہقی شعب الایمان) اسی لیے آپ ﷺ نے ایک موقع پر فرمایا:

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رمضان کا خاص خیال رکھو کیونکہ یہ اللہ تعالیٰ کا مہینہ ہے جو بڑی برکت والا اور بلند شان والا ہے۔ اس نے تمہارے لیے گیارہ ماہ چھوڑ دیئے ہیں جن میں تم کھاتے ہو اور پیتے ہو اور ہر قسم کی لذات حاصل کرتے ہو مگر اس نے اپنے لیے ایک مہینہ کو خاص کر لیا ہے۔ (مجمع الزوائد)

* اس مہینہ کو ”سید الشہور“ یعنی تمام مہینوں کا سردار بھی کہا جاتا ہے۔

* رمضان کے آخری عشرہ میں رسول کریم ﷺ اعتکاف فرمایا کرتے تھے۔ آپ ﷺ کی سنت کے مطابق روزے دار بھی مساجد میں آخری عشرہ میں اعتکاف بیٹھتے ہیں۔ یاد رہے کہ اعتکاف صرف مسجد میں ہوتا ہے، گھروں میں جو بہنیں اعتکاف بیٹھتی ہیں وہ عبادت میں شمار ہوتا ہے۔ سوائے اس کے کہ کوئی جان لیوا یا پھیلی ہو، جیسے کووڈ ۱۹ جیسی موذی وبا جس سے لاکھوں لوگ اپنی جانیں ہار بیٹھے تھے۔

* لیلة القدر بھی اس مہینے کے آخری عشرے کی طاق راتوں میں تلاش کی جاتی ہے۔

* رسول کریم ﷺ نے فرمایا ہے۔ جس نے رمضان کے روزے ایمان اور خالص نیت کے ساتھ رکھے، اُس کے پچھلے گناہ بخش دیئے جائیں گے۔ (صحیح بخاری و صحیح مسلم) حضرت ابوسعید خدریؓ بیان کرتے ہیں کہ آنحضرت ﷺ نے فرمایا:

جب کوئی رمضان کے پہلے دن روزہ رکھتا ہے تو اس کے پہلے سب گناہ بخش دیئے جاتے ہیں۔ اسی طرح ہر روز ماہ رمضان میں ہوتا ہے اور ہر روز اس کے لیے ستر ہزار فرشتے اس کی بخشش کی دعائیں صبح کی نماز سے لے کر ان کے پردوں میں چھپنے تک کرتے ہیں۔ (کنز العمال - کتاب الصوم) حضرت مسیح موعود علیہ السلام رمضان کے روزوں کی اہمیت بیان کرتے ہوئے فرماتے ہیں:

”میری تو یہ حالت ہے کہ مرنے کے قریب ہو جاؤں تب روزہ چھوڑتا ہوں۔ طبیعت روزہ چھوڑنے کو نہیں چاہتی۔ یہ

مبارک دن ہیں اور اللہ تعالیٰ کے فضل و رحمت کے نزول کے دن ہیں۔“ (الحکم ۲۴، جنوری ۱۹۰۱ء صفحہ ۵)

* رمضان سنہ ۸ ہجری کو مکہ فتح ہوا۔ (نبیوں کا سردار، صفحہ ۲۰۵)

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The 9th Lunar Month: Ramadhan

Ramadan is a month of immense spiritual significance, during which a person fasts for the pleasure of Allah and experiences spiritual zeal and enhanced devotion. Through these acts, individuals attain both spiritual and physical vitality, which leads to growth and development. Fasting often involves enduring challenges such as hunger, thirst, and sacrificing sleep for night prayers. However, the pure-hearted believers recognize that these sacrifices result in Allah's immense rewards and blessings.

For this reason, true believers eagerly await this spiritual spring throughout the year, preparing themselves to fully absorb its divine grace. They continue their spiritual practices with consistency so that they can intensify them during this blessed month. When Ramadan arrives, they embrace its challenges wholeheartedly, working tirelessly to seek Allah's mercy. The essence of these efforts is reflected in the name "Ramadan", which carries profound meanings explained below.

Why Was Ramadan Named Ramadan?

According to some linguists, the old name of Ramadan was "**Natq**." In the Arabic lexicon *Taj al-Arus*, it is mentioned:

"Natq, this month, which is now called Ramadan, was its name in the old language."

Similarly, *Lisan al-Arab* explains the word "**Natq**" as meaning "to uproot or shake." The Quran mentions:

"And [remember] when We shook the mountain over them as if it was a canopy." (*Surah Al-A'raf: 172*)

The name **Ramadan** originates from the Arabic root "**Ramad**," which means "intense heat." During the time the name was assigned (around 412 CE, during the era of Kilab bin Murrah, an ancestor of the Prophet Muhammad (sas)), the weather was extremely hot.

However, **Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as)**, the Promised Messiah, explains: **"Linguists suggest that Ramadan was named because it coincided with summer heat. I do not agree with this, as it cannot be specific to the Arabs. Instead, the spiritual meaning of Ramadan is a period of spiritual zeal and fervor."** (*Malfuzat, Vol. 1, Page 136*)

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Meanings of Ramadan

1. **Spiritual Heat and Passion:** The Promised Messiah (as) states: *"Ramadan refers to the heat of the sun. During Ramadan, one abstains from food, drink, and bodily pleasures, developing a fervor for Allah's commands. This merging of spiritual and physical heat embodies Ramadan. The term also refers to the heat that warms stones and other objects."* (Malfuzat, Vol. 1, Page 136)
2. **Relief from Spiritual Ailments and Pains:** Hazrat Khalifatul Masih III (ra) explains: *"The word Ramadan is derived from 'Ramad,' which can mean to burn or cause pain. Those who are weak in faith may see Ramadan as a month of hunger, thirst, and hardship. However, Allah's pious servants do not view it this way. Instead, they recognize the spiritual benefits and blessings that outweigh any physical difficulties."* (Khutbat Nasir, Vol. 1, Pages 54-55)
3. **Paradise Awaits:** Ramadan is the month that Paradise prepares for throughout the year. It is reported in Hadith: *"The Prophet (sas) used to fast three days each month, anticipating the thirty days of Ramadan."* (Shu'ab al-Iman, Kitab al-Siyam). Hazrat Abu Hurairah (ra) narrates that the Prophet (sas) advised him: *"Observe three fasts each month, offer Duha prayer, and perform Witr before sleeping."* (Sahih Bukhari, Kitab al-Sawm)
4. **Increasing in Goodness:** The word "Ramad" also means "sharpening." In a Hadith, it is likened to sharpening a blade on a stone, symbolizing how Ramadan refines and intensifies spiritual acts. Hazrat Ibn Abbas (ra) narrates: *"The Prophet (sas) was the most generous of people, and he was even more generous during Ramadan when Jibreel (AS) met him nightly to review the Quran. During these visits, the Prophet's generosity surpassed the swiftest winds."* (Sahih Bukhari, Kitab al-Sawm). Hazrat Khalifatul Masih III (ra) adds: *"In Ramadan, believers sharpen their spiritual weapons—nightly prayers and supplications—to achieve their goals more effectively."* (Khutbat Nasir, Vol. 1, Page 55)
5. **Seeking Mercy Despite Hardships:** In his work *Aqrab al-Mawarid*, Sa'id ibn Abdullah al-Shartouni explains that "**Ramad**" refers to rain that falls after intense heat, cooling the scorched earth. Hazrat Khalifatul Masih III (ra) interprets this: *"A believer, like a determined hunter, endures hunger, thirst, and exhaustion, seeking Allah's mercy. These difficulties do not deter them; rather, they intensify their pursuit. Just as rain soothes the scorched earth, Allah's mercy soothes the hearts of His servants."* (Khutbat Nasir, Vol. 1)

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Ramadan: A Month of Spiritual Revival

The Prophet (sas) described Sha'ban as a cloud and Ramadan as rain. This analogy signifies that Ramadan is the culmination of spiritual preparation, showering believers with Allah's mercy. The word Sha'ban (meaning branch) and Ramadan (heat and rain) together highlight this journey of growth, purification, and fulfillment.

During this month, believers intensify their prayers, fasts, and charity, striving to reach their highest spiritual potential and reap the abundant blessings Allah bestows in this sacred period.

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“Hence, I loudly proclaim once again, and my friends ought to take heed that they must not disregard my words of advice and view them as the tales of a story-teller. Everything that I have said to you, I have said with a burning heart and true sympathy, which are inherently a part of my soul. Heed my words with the ear of your heart and act upon them.”

Areeba, a long-serving and devoted member of Lajna Ima'illah, has always taken pride in her loyalty to the Jamaat and her dedication to Khilafat. Recently, during a regional meeting, a senior Jamaat officeholder made an unnecessarily harsh and dismissive comment toward her suggestion in front of others. Areeba felt humiliated and disheartened. She began to wonder whether her sincere efforts were even valued and quietly withdrew from attending meetings and participating in initiatives. Though her love for the Jamaat remains, she feels conflicted — struggling to reconcile personal hurt with her spiritual responsibilities.
